



## Luke 5:1-11

### Supplemental Scripture

Luke 4:43 Job 42 Isaiah 6:5

### Discussion Questions for Personal Life and Community Gathering

1. **Listen.** Read Luke 5:1-3. What was Jesus doing here? How is that consistent with the end of Luke 4?

Discuss the significance of Jesus being in Peter's boat? How is Jesus stepping into your life presently?

2. **Trust.** Read Luke 5:4-7. What does Jesus ask of Peter in verse 4?

What is Peter's first response in verse 5? Why?

What was Peter's final response and action in verses 5-6? What was the result?

What do you learn about Jesus here? What is Jesus calling you to right now that does not make sense? How are you responding?

3. **Penitence.** Read Luke 5:8-10a. Compare verses 5 and 8. How does the way Peter address Jesus change?

What does this lead Peter to do?

Consider your life. Are you in awe of Jesus? Is He your master or is He your Lord? How does this affect the way you live your life?

4. **Discipleship.** Read Luke 10b-11. How does Jesus respond to Peter's proclamation in verse 8?

To what does Jesus call Peter? How do the men respond?

Close by discussing what the call of a disciple truly is. What does it require? Who is called to it? Are you a disciple?
