### Supplemental Scripture

### Discussion Questions for Personal Life and Community Gathering

- 1. Know.** Read the following quote from John Calvin and spend some personal reflection time with the questions that follow. Journal your answers and if time allows share them in your gathering discussion.

*“Nearly all the wisdom we possess, that is to say, true and sound wisdom, consists of two parts: the knowledge of God and of ourselves.”*

Why is knowledge of God important? Why is knowledge of you important? How do the two relate? What have you learned about God this past year? What about yourself?

- 2. Leprosy.** Read Luke 5:12-16. Discuss the physical state of the man in verse 12.

What was the man’s request? Discuss the significance of the man’s request in light of the culture and the law. What does this say about his faith?

What was Jesus’ response?

Connect the physical to the spiritual. What is your leprosy? What is your healing? How does this affect your faith in your daily life?

- 3. Live.** Read Luke 5:17-26. Spend a few minutes and discuss what happens in verses 17-19.

What is Jesus’ response in verse 20 and 24? What happens in verse 25? What was the response of the crowd in verse 26?

Based on this passage, consider the following questions in your personal time, family worship, and missional community gathering.

- Who are you bringing to Jesus?
- What trouble are you going through to bring others to Jesus?
- Are you living life with a sense of amazement?
- When is the last time you witnessed something extraordinary?
