Discussion Questions for Personal Life and Community Gathering

1. **The Kingdom.** The Kingdom of God is a pervasive theme throughout the Gospel of Luke. What is the Kingdom of God?

Discuss Jesus' connection to the Kingdom. What is your connection to the Kingdom? How do you live in the Kingdom? Does it feel real and tangible to you? Why or why not?

2. **Kingdom People.** Consider Luke 6:12-16. What two groups of people does Jesus call here? What's the difference between these two groups?

Thinking of your local context and time in history, what does it mean to be a disciple? What does it mean to be an apostle?

3. **Kingdom Life.** What is discipleship?

Read Philippians 3:7-11. What is the cost of discipleship? What are the rewards of discipleship?

Discuss the four spheres of discipleship mentioned in the sermon. What is the role of the Christian in each sphere? The role of the church?

Spend some time in personal reflection this week and answer the following questions:

- Am I a Kingdom person?
- Am I exhibiting Kingdom life on Kingdom mission?
- How is discipleship evidenced in my life? In my family life? In my church? In my interaction with the world?
