Supplemental Scripture

Isaiah 43:1-2 Psalm 107:25-37

Discussion Questions for Personal Life and Community Gathering

Read Luke 8:22-25, Isaiah 43:1-2, and Psalm 107:25-37 and answer the questions below.

1. Interpretation. Why do you think Jesus led the disciples right into the storm?

Why was Jesus able to fall asleep when He knew what was coming?

What is the ultimate storm in our life that should cause us to cry out, “Master, we are perishing”?

List some other biblical examples of how God controlled the wind and the waters.

What does this say about Jesus that His single word was able to rebuke the winds?

2. Application. Take some time to share personal stories of suffering in your own life.

How has God been faithful through that particular storm?

What have you learned about yourself? About God? About life?

How has it strengthened your faith?

During your gathering time this week, close by intentionally praying for one another in your group specifically. Try to limit your focus to the specific personal needs of yourself and those in your group.

Afterwards, close by sharing how it feels to have others in your life to share in suffering along with you?
