



Luke 9:1-9 “Jesus is Our Sender”

Supplemental Scripture

Matthew 28:18-20 Acts 1:8 Mark 4:26-29 Matthew 10:16-33

Discussion Questions for Personal Life and Community Gathering

1. **The Sent.** Read Luke 6:1-6. How did Jesus equip the disciples in verse 1 (what did He give them)? What are both of these important?

What were the disciples sent to do?

Consider Luke 9:3-5 and Matthew 10:16-33. How did Jesus prepare the disciples for their mission? How is this helpful for us today?

2. **The Sender.** Think about how Jesus sent out the disciples. How was this consistent with His message and His life?

How did Jesus proclaim the Kingdom on earth? How do we now proclaim the Kingdom on earth?

3. **Success.** Review Luke 9:6. What did the disciples do? What does this tell us about success in terms of Kingdom work?

Read Mark 4:26-29. What is our responsibility? What is God’s “responsibility”? How does this compare to our culture in the world and in the church? How does this liberate you to do Kingdom work?

Compare this account to our commission in Matthew 28:18-20 and Acts 1:8. What do we learn about our Savior and our mission here?

4. **You.** In your personal time this week read Matthew 16:24-27. Pray, journal, and meditate on this passage as you answer the following questions. If time permits share your answers in your family time or small group gathering.

- Do I believe that Jesus is who He says He is?
- Am I willing to go on mission with Him
- How can I deny myself today?
- How can I take up my cross today?
- How can I follow Christ today?
